

Haley House Helpings

A volunteer experience combining food with purpose and the power of community

<u>About:</u> Haley House Helpings is a team-building engagement that involves supporting the soup kitchen or food pantry shifts. In the soup kitchen, volunteers prepare, serve, and clean up the soup kitchen. During breaks, volunteers can eat the meal and sit down to chat with guests. In the food pantry, volunteers unload the van, bag groceries, and distribute them to guests.

Haley House uses food with purpose and the power of community to break down barriers between people, empower individuals, and strengthen neighborhoods. We believe in radical solutions: solving problems at their root by challenging attitudes that perpetuate suffering and building alternative models.

How it Works: Your group will arrive onsite at 23 Dartmouth St., receive an informational greeting from Haley House staff, and then be led through the Haley House Helpings experience by members of our Live-in Community.

Impact: Haley House Helpings ensures that we are able to provide nutritious and high-quality meals & groceries to our guests at the Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry. It also supports Haley House's urban agriculture, *Life Foundations Training* reentry program, *Take Back the Kitchen* cooking classes, and more!

<u>Group Details</u>: Our kitchen is not large, so the shifts work best with groups of 8 people. All participants must be at least 18 years old.

Scheduling: We schedule *Haley House Helpings* groups for Soup Kitchen shifts 6 am -10 am, Monday-Friday, and 10 am - 2 pm on Sundays. Food Pantry shifts are 9:15-10:30 am, Thursdays. Because our staff and guests depend on your commitment, we charge a cancellation fee of \$300 if your group cancels within a week of your confirmed date.
